Stage 3 key learning areas of Gold plus Global Environments - Rainforests: Your students will develop knowledge, understanding and the ability to critically explore important issues from our heritage:

- The influence of the discovery of gold on the Australian identity and environment
- The significant events, actions and lifestyles from the perspective of the people living at that time
- Participation in activities that contribute to environmental sustainability
- Discussion of different perspectives about the maintenance and improvement of environments.
- Camp craft (including shelter, fires and cooking)
- Care of the environment (including minimal impact practices, sanitation, care of waterways and rubbish disposal)
- First aid, safety and equipment use
- Group skills including leadership and teamwork
- Skills specific to mode of activity (ie. canoeing skills, hiking skills, ropes, survival skills etc.)
